It documents a hiking tour to the **Wallberg**-mountain in the Bavarian Alps, **ca 1935/36**In his handwriting Erich attached titles to his photos.

But who is "Oma"?

"Erich, Mama, Papa and Oma".

Erich's grandmother from Memmelsdorf had already died before his birth in 1924, his Memmelsdorf grandfather in 1935. Grandfather **Fantl**, on his mother's side, had died in Furth im Wald in 1931; his wife, Erich's grandmother, had fled to Czechoslovakia in 1933 with her family. Crossing the border into Germany was no longer possible.

We think the white-haired elderly woman with a walking cane must be **Trina Kuttner**, **the** "substitute **Oma"**.
